Follow up reports on the action taken and outcome analysis

The feedback received from parents was compiled by the IQAC and presented before the Dean and the College Council. Based on these findings the following steps were taken for undergraduate students during 2020-21:

ACADEMICS

- Online teaching and formative assessment conducted successfully using the MGIMS Classroom which is a MOODLE based learning management system. Google Meet was used to conduct synchronous sessions. This was possible because 100 teachers were already trained in MOODLE in 2015-16
- 2. Teachers were supported and trained in enhancing student engagement online by the Medical Education Unit.
- 3. Course was completed on time despite hurdles due to the pandemic.
- 4. Almost 50% of undergraduates preferred to stay back on campus. They were provided a safe and sterile environment.
- 5. Library remained closed. However access to online books and journals through the library portal ensured that students were not affected adversely.

INFRASTRUCTURE

- 1. Funding has been received from the alumni of the institute for construction of two new hostel blocks. Space has been identified and two new hostel blocks with 50 rooms each are being constructed over a total area of 25300 sq m
- 2. Renovation of Pathology Lecture Hall and Pathology Department done. The lecture hall has been equipped with air conditioners and a new LCD projection system. Now classes are held comfortably despite the temperatures above 45 degrees C in summers

HOSTELS

- 1. The hostel advisory committees of both hostels reviewed the safety and security measures in the hostels in view of the pandemic. All COVID-related protocols were followed
- 2. Mess protocols were reviewed to avoid crowding and spread of infection
