188 Covid-9 patients discharged after full recovery

210 new cases in the state today

13 deaths due to Covid-19 today

State tally now 1574

210 new Covid-19 cases were reported today in the state taking the state tally to 1574. There were 13 deaths in the state of Covid-19 patients.

Out of the deaths from today, 10 deaths were recorded in Mumbai, and 1 each in Pune, Panvel and Vasai-Virar. Out of the 13 deaths today, 9 were men and 4 women. 6 of them aged over 60 years, 5 patients were from the age group 40 to 60 years and 2 were less than 40 years old. 11 patients (85%) had high-risk co-morbidities such as diabetes, hypertension, asthma and heart disease.

These have taken the death toll in the state due to Covid-19 to 110.

Out of 33,093 laboratory samples, 30,477 were negative and 1574 have been tested positive for coronavirus until today. 188 patients have been discharged till date after full recovery. 38,927 people are in home quarantine and 4738 people are in institutional quarantine.

As per the guidance from Government of India, cluster containment action plan is being implemented in places where clusters of patients have been found in the state. There are total 4374 surveillance squads deployed across the state and surveillance of over 16.5 lakh population has been done.
