

CODE OF CONDUCTS, RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Students admitted to Mahatma Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Sevagram are expected to follow the code of conduct as follows
 - a. wearing khadi clothes
 - b. consume vegetarian meals
 - c. eschew smoking, drinking and other intoxicants
 - d. participate in community prayer, shramdan and such other activities as may be prescribed from time to time
 - e. must be free from any prejudice regarding, caste, creed or untouchability
- 2 Residing in the hostels of the Institute is compulsory for all students.
- 3 Students after admission to the Institute are given an Orientation Training Course for a fortnight in Sevagram Ashram for getting sensitized to Gandhian ideology.
- 4 Attendance in the Social Service camp for 15 days in an adopted village in Wardha district. The participation in Social Service Camp is essential.
- 5 We shall also follow other conditions as prescribed by Government of Maharashtra, Govt. of India and by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik.
